Faithful Fivers

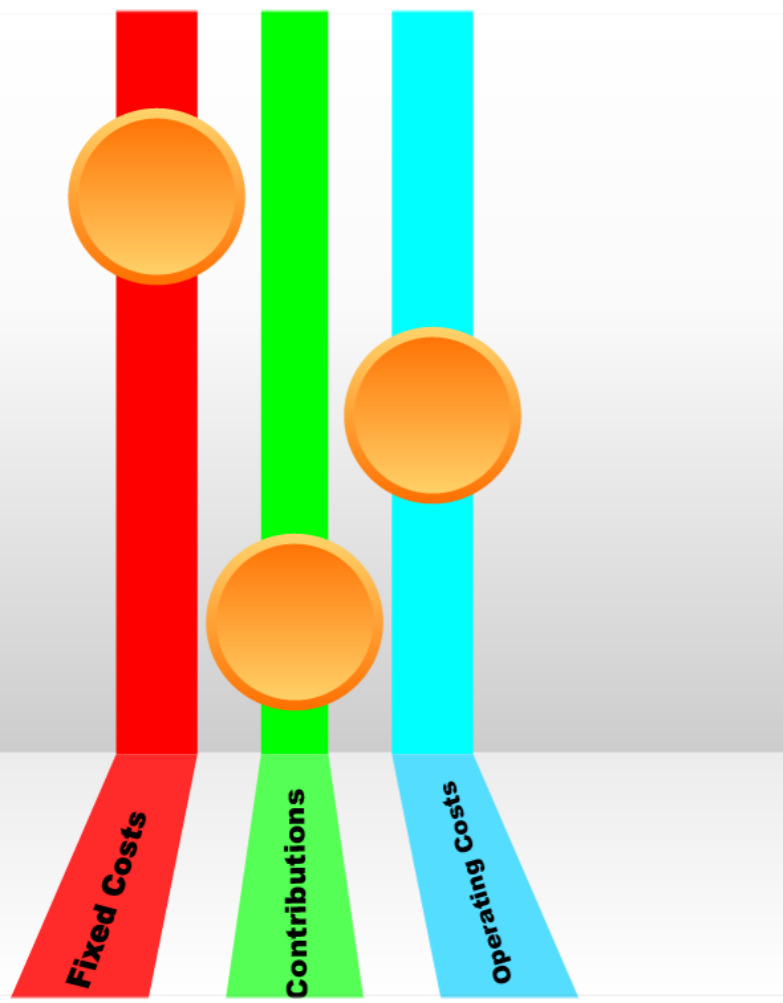
26 out of over 5,000 A.A. members in St. Paul are Faithful Fivers - members who contribute a specific amount on a regular basis.

OUR CHALLENGES



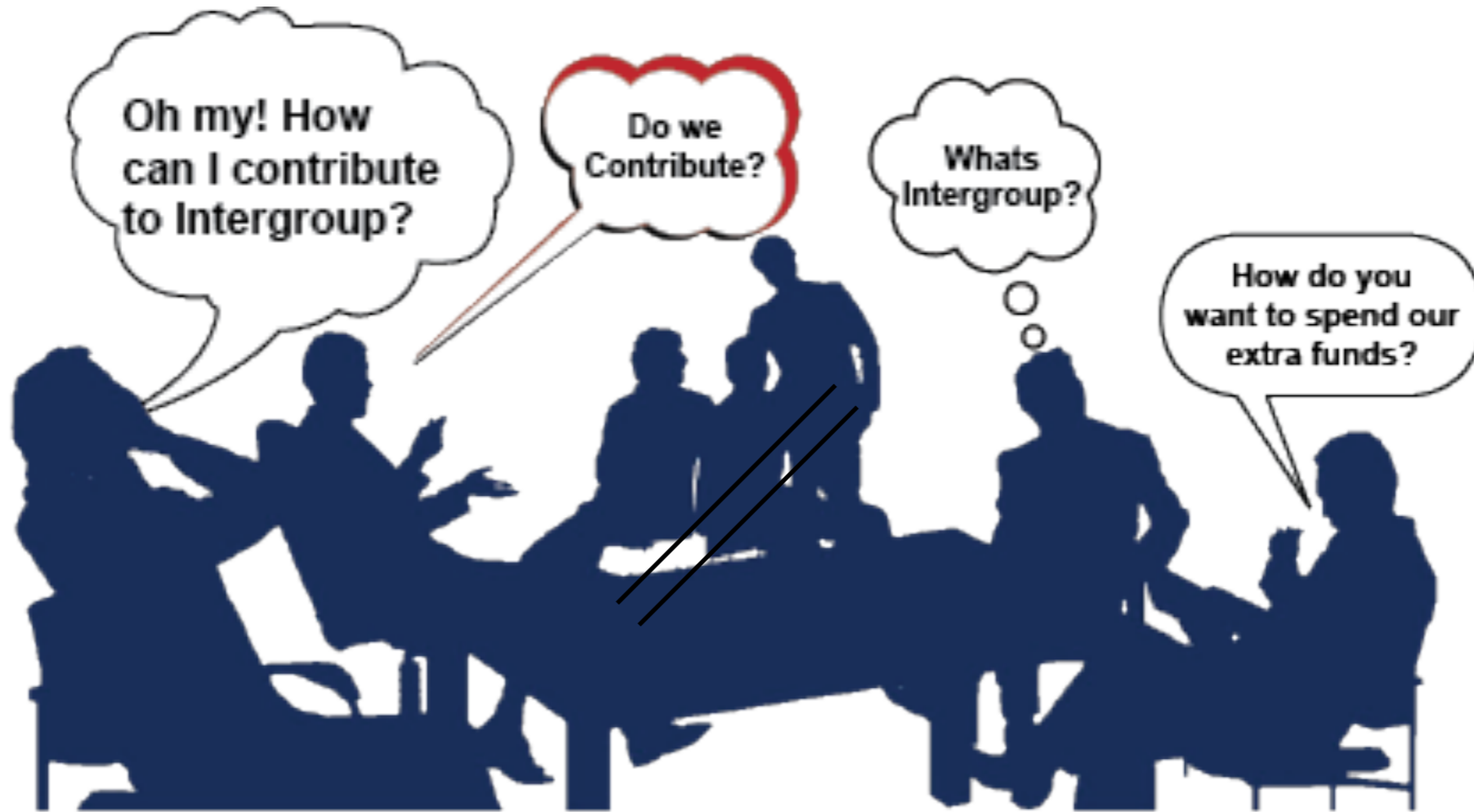
- Somewhat flat sales over the last year.
- Only slight rise in Contributions

- Cost of inventory (Literature and Merchandise) is increasing.
- Costs of contracted services (phone, internet, etc) are increasing.
- Potential increase in facility leasing cost due to need to move.
- Ongoing staff training on software and hardware

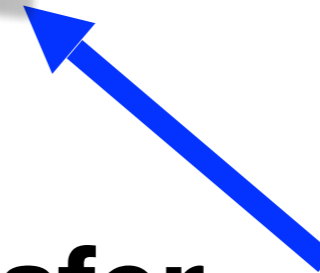
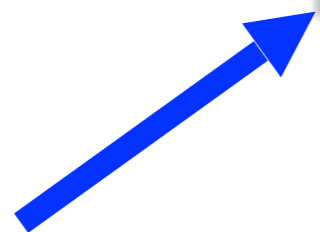
